

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOWICK

BY-LAW NO. 38 - 2007

**A by-law to adopt a Smoke Alarm Program and a Home Escape Planning Program
for the Township of Howick**

WHEREAS the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997, Section 2 (1)(a)* requires that every municipality shall establish a program which must include public education with respect to fire safety and certain components of fire prevention, including a smoke alarm program,

AND WHEREAS the purpose and objective of a municipal smoke alarm and home escape planning program is the provision and maintenance of working smoke alarms and escape planning activities for all residential occupancies in the Township,

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Howick deems it desirable and expedient to establish a smoke alarm and home escape planning program for the benefit and safety of the residents of the municipality,

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Howick hereby enacts as follows:

1. THAT the ***“Township of Howick Smoke Alarm and Home Escape Planning Program”*** as outlined in Schedule ‘A’ of this by-law is hereby adopted.
2. THAT Schedule ‘A’ hereto attached is composite of and an integral part of this by-law.
3. THAT this by-law comes into force and effect on the date of final passing, and shall remain in force until amended or repealed by Council of the Township of Howick.

READ A FIRST AND SECOND TIME THIS 4TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 2007.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 4TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 2007.
